TAILORING

Length Fittings for Tailoring

As well as offering skirts and trousers in various lengths, all of our ranges of jackets for both men and women are available in short, regular and long fittings.

The following is a general guide to their fit:	
Men	
Short	Up to 5' 7" (173cm)
Regular	5' 8" (175cm) – 5' 11" (180cm)
Long	6' 0" (178cm) – 6' 3" (190cm)
Women	
Petite	Up to 5' 3" (155cm)
Regular	5' 4" (160cm) – 5' 8" (172cm)
Long	5' 9" (177cm) and over

MEASURING

Bust or Chest (under the jacket)

Ladies measure around the fullest part of the bust, keeping the tape level at all times. Men measure right around the chest, well up under the arms, keeping the tape level and held gently.

Waist

Measure around the body, level with top of waistband.

Hips

Measure at approximately 8" (20cms) below the waistline to the widest part of the hipline.

Trouser Inside Leg

Place the tape at the fork position and continue down the leg to the seam line of your shoe heel.
Alternatively measure a favourite pair of trousers.

GARMENT CARE

It is essential to read carefully the care instructions shown on the garment label.

These care recommendations have been chosen to give the best results in cleaning, drying and ironing. It is important that they are followed to maintain the good appearance and wear life of the garment.

- Always wash dark and bright colours before wearing to prevent possible colour rubbing onto lighter garments or skin.
- Wash dark or bright colours separately to avoid staining of light colours in the wash.
- For best results do not mix fabrics with different fibre content in the same washload.
- Wash garments frequently to prevent heavy soiling.
- If tumble drying is recommended, you should select temperature/cycle duration setting from the wash temperature given on the label, e.g. if washing at 40°C then tumble dry at warm, if washing at 50°C+ then tumble dry at hot. Never overdry, to prevent shrinkage of fabric or garment.
- 100% cotton garments benefit from being pressed whilst still slightly damp.
- Reshape knitted garments whilst damp.
